PATIENT RESPONSIBILITIES

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility to read and understand all permits and/or consents to be signed: Either ask the nurse or physician to clarify any information not understood about your care or services.

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility to answer all medical questions truthfully, to the best of knowledge including complete information about your symptoms, past illnesses, allergies or sensitivities, hospitalizations, surgeries, existing advanced directive, medications (including over the counter products and dietary supplements), and other matters relating to your plan of care.

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility to follow the pre-operative instructions given by the physician and/or Houston Orthopedic Surgery Center.

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility to notify Houston Orthopedic Surgery Center upon admission if pre-operative instructions have not been followed. The PATIENT will be responsible for their actions if they refuse treatment or do not follow preoperative instructions.

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility to provide a responsible adult to transport him/her to and from Houston Orthopedic Surgery Center and to remain with him/her for 24 hours if required by his/her provider.

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility to follow the post-operative instructions given by the physician(s) and/or nurses. This includes instructions regarding post-operative appointments.

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility to contact the physician if any complications occur.

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility to assure all payments for service rendered are on a timely basis and ultimate responsibility is the patients, regardless of the insurance coverage. It is the PATIENT'S responsibility to provide financial and/or insurance information regarding who will be responsible for the bill including current address and authorized contact information.

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility to notify the administration of Houston Orthopedic Surgery Center if the PATIENT or the PATIENT REPRESENTATIVE thinks their right(s) have been violated or if the PATIENT has a significant complaint.

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility and those accompanying the PATIENT to respect the rights of other patients and Houston Orthopedic Surgery Center personnel without regard to race, color, religion, sex, age, gender preference, handicap, or national origin and follow the Center's policies.

It is the PATIENT's responsibility to be respectful of others and their property and the property of HOSC. Patients are to observe safety and no smoking regulations.

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility to follow the treatment plan prescribed by his/her provider and participate in his/her care.

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility to notify Houston Orthopedic Surgery Center (HOSC) if they have been exposed, tested positive, or have any symptoms of COVID-19 prior to surgery and for two weeks post surgery. You and your family may be required to wear a mask while at HOSC.

It is the PATIENT'S responsibility for the disposition of their valuables, as HOSC does not assume the responsibility.
